

At La Casa Esperanza

La Casa Esperanza is a temporary shelter for women and girls from Dumaguete City and neighboring towns. They are fully supported by the Local Government Unit (LGU) through the City Social Welfare Development Office. They offer a residential care facility providing temporary shelter to individuals in crisis situations throughout the province of Negros Oriental. Their major clientele include physically abused women and children, rape cases, and incest cases. They also assist runaway/ lost children, stranded persons, and witnesses in court. (ABVP) Last February 15, 2015, Ablazer International had their mini outreach in this institution. Instead of going to a fancy restaurant to have a date, they dedicate their time to the children living in La Casa Esperanza. They sang songs and let the children play some games. Some activities include face painting and drawing contest. Some leaders got the chance to have a conversation with some of the girls. Indeed, it was a successful and fulfilling activity.
